To whom it may concern,

Marly Driskell provided nighttime nanny services for our family for ten weeks. We had quadruplets who were born prematurely at 30 weeks. They remained in the hospital until their original due date two months later. At that time, we asked Marly to come to our home for eight hours on six nights per week to handle the nighttime feeds. She handled three of their feeds alone, which allowed us to sleep through the night. We valued the ability to rest at night so we could patiently handle the daytime duties of caring for four preemie infants all day.

She followed our instructions on when and how to feed, how much to give, whether and when to add rice cereal, etc. She kept us informed on how every night went through a summary email every morning. This was important for us to understand how the children handled the night and helped us determine when they were ready to stretch the time in between their feeds, drop a feed, and – eventually – sleep through the night.

She shared ideas with us that had worked well in the past based on her experience. She also helped us monitor the babies for any health concerns, such as fevers after vaccinations and signs of sickness after I came down with a respiratory illness. This was very helpful since our quadruplets were our first children!

During her down time, she completed other baby-related tasks like folding and putting away laundry, restocking supplies in the various changing stations, and prepping the morning bottles. She also handled bathing the children.

We completely trusted her to stay in our home overnight while we slept. She would also come early some nights so that we could have a date night. We knew she could handle the children alone, which gave us the peace of mind to be able to leave for an evening out.

We found her through a referral from a triplet family and were very pleased with her professionalism, friendliness, and how well she cared for and loved on the children.

We highly recommend her to other families.
