Marly's employment as our children's nanny began in August of 2000, at which time our older son was almost three years old and our younger son was an infant. We were fortunate to have known Marly prior to her employment because she worked in the nursery at our church.

I wholeheartedly recommend Marly as a nanny for any child, from infant through elementary school and beyond. She was always caring and responsible in her care of our baby. As the boys grew, she was good at entertaining them and taking them on enriching outings. As our older son entered school and began homework assignments, she capably supervised the process. Our son credits Marly's work for his strong reading skills - he was placed in the top reading group in the first grade.
